What's this questionnaire for?

If your child is due to attend a Warwickshire school, you should complete the School Readiness Health Questionnaire online before they start. It helps identify if they have any health and wellbeing needs that they may require support with in order to reach their full potential as they enter education.

Who will read my answers?

Your completed questionnaire is sent to Connect for Health, the local school nursing service who take over from Health Visiting when your child starts school. Your answers are treated confidentially and stored securely online. A nurse will review your questionnaire and we may contact you to provide advice, information and support.
