Last week our school governors spent some time in school visiting classes and talking to children about their work and school life. This is the first time they have been in school in nearly two years due to the pandemic. They were thrilled at the work ethic they observed from children in classes as well as noting how happy and settled they were. A group of children met with the governors and were only too pleased to proudly show their work and explain their learning. The children within our school are a real credit to their families and I am so proud of them.

With Christmas on the horizon, many of you will be wondering if the children will be performing a Christmas Play. I'm sure you will be delighted to hear that the answer is YES! We believe these experiences are such an important part of life at infant school and we were so disappointed that this wasn't possible last year.

However, when planning events such as this we need to be mindful that we are still living through a pandemic and the pre pandemic behaviours of filling the hall with families will not be possible. Each year group will perform their play twice, once in the morning and once in the afternoon. There will be a maximum audience size of 45 at each performance so with 90 children in a year, each family will be issued with ONE ticket for EITHER the morning or afternoon performance. I know that this may be upsetting for some of you that only one adult will get to see the show but I'm sure that you will agree that this is still far better than there being no audience and no show. We will, however, be allowing parents to record the play for personal use only with the understanding it will not be shared on social media sites.

Our hall can be well ventilated, and it is likely you will be asked to wear a face mask whilst watching the show. We will send more details nearer the time about mitigations that we have put in place for the audience as well as how we will be allocating tickets.
