- A senses journey to school using your senses to discover what you can see, hear, smell, touch and taste on your way to school.
- Make a map of your journey to school.
- Look through family albums at home, using historical language to talk about them.
- Make a family tree.
- Counting house numbers and recognising house numbers.
- Learn their address and house number.
- Create your own home through painting, drawing and building etc.
- Gather photos, images, objects, artefacts, leaflets and tickets etc from the local area.
