| nurse | a person who cares for the sick, especially in hospital |
| police officer | a person who enforces the law and makes our country a safe place to live |
| firefighter | a person whose job is to put out fires |
| bakery | a place where bread and cakes are made or sold |
| feelings | a reaction to a situation or event |
| bus | a large vehicle that carries passengers |
| healthy | in a good physical or mental condition |
