#### Children late for school

It is important that your child is on time for school each day.

Registration is at 8.55 am and children must be in their class by this time to get their mark.



Year group doors are open between 8.45 am and 8.55 am when children can come into school via their year group doors.

Year group doors will be locked promptly at 8.55 am in order for the school day to begin. If you arrive after this time you will need to go via the main school office entrance where your child will get a late mark.

If your child is late you will be asked to provide a reason for lateness.

Some children have been arriving late regularly for school, this means that they are missing the start of the school day and if children are in school for the start of the day and for when the register is taken it helps them to start off the day ready to learn and feel comfortable in knowing the routine of what is happening during the school day. Many children tell us they don't like being late and wish they could arrive at the same time as their friends.

Parents of children that come to school late will be sent a letter and may be asked to come into school for a meeting with Miss Telford.

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#### **Direct Payments webinar for families with SEND**

Are you a parent or carer of a child or young person with special educational needs and or disabilities (SEND)? Would you like to know more about direct payments and how they work? If so, why not attend our latest SEND webinar on direct payments to find out more.

The free webinar which is being run by Warwickshire County Council (WCC) in partnership with Penderels Trust and WCC's Independent Living Team will take place on Friday 27 January from 1pm to 2pm.

The Children and Families Act gives parents and carers of children with Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCP), and young people over the age of 16, greater choice and control over their support arrangements. If a child or young person receives an EHCP you will be able to request a personal budget, part of which might be available through a direct payment.

To help support families with the direct payments process, the webinar will cover:

- Direct payments and personal budgets what they are, how they are used and how they are paid.
- What can (and what can't) be funded through them.
- The roles and responsibilities of Warwickshire County Council.
- Employers' responsibilities for those using direct payments to employ staff.
- Support provided by Penderels Trust to set up a direct payment.
- The difference between a managed and a non-managed direct payment.
- How the payroll service works at Penderels Trust.
