It has become something of a tradition at Nathaniel Newton to hold an Easter bonnet

There will be a first and second prize awarded in each Year group. Children should bring their bonnet into school on <u>Friday 31st March</u> ready for judging during the morning. Weather permitting we will parade around the playground from <u>2.30pm</u> starting with Reception. Once Reception have paraded Year 1 will come out to parade followed by Year 2.

Mother's Day Celebration Afternoon Friday 17th March

We are really looking forward to welcoming mums (or another significant female in the child's life) into school on Friday. Please find below the arrangements for Friday so that we can ensure the afternoon runs smoothly.

- 1. Upon arrival at 1.30pm, please go to the main playground as you would at the end of the day and form the usual queues. If you arrive after 1.30pm, please enter school via the office.
- 2. A member of staff from the classes will collect you and take you into the classrooms where you will be required to sign in on a register.
- 3. Once in school, staff will explain the activities for the afternoon to you.
- 4. Each Year Group will be doing a little presentation to mums in classes and you will be reminded of the times for this at the beginning of the afternoon.
- 5. For those ladies who have booked an afternoon tea, you will be given a ticket by a member of staff once you arrive. Please take your ticket to the kitchen to collect your order. There will be chairs and tables set up in the hall. There will be a drink and cake for the children in their year groups so they can collect these and join you in the hall with these.
- 6. If you have more than one child in the school, you can have both/all children together and divide your time between their year groups.
- 7. If you have younger children, you may bring them with you. If there is someone who you can leave your younger child with, that may be an option to consider, as you can then give your child in school undivided attention during the afternoon.
- 8. Mobile phones are not to be used in classrooms during the afternoon to receive calls or send messages this is part of our safeguarding policy. However, we will allow you to take photographs of your child on your phone if you wish. The usual principles will apply about ensuring that photographs that may contain other children must not be shared on social media.
- 9. At 2.45pm, we will ask parents to return to the playground in order for staff to prepare children for the end of the day. As soon as the classes are ready, staff will bring them out to you so they may be a few minutes earlier than usual.

If another relative will be attending in your place, please can you ensure that you share the above information with them.

We hope you have a lovely, special time with your child on Friday and we look forward to welcoming you.


