

Academic Year 23-24 After School club provision

Dear Parents/Carers

We hope all of our pupils enjoyed accessing our after school clubs last academic year.

Unfortunately, this year it is necessary for us to return to making a small charge for our after school club provision. We already subsidise the cost of after school clubs, and this charge helps towards the cost of external club providers and resources needed to provision the activities. In most cases, the charge will be £2 per session per pupil. Children eligible for Pupil Premium will continue to receive access to clubs free of charge. If you are unsure whether you qualify for this benefit, please speak to us about how to apply.

This year we are changing the platform which books our after school clubs to 'School Cloud'. Please use the web address below to access the website and login in by providing your own details and that of your child. These details **MUST** match the details that we hold for you here at school for you to be able to log in.

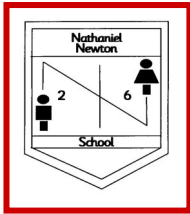
As places are still limited, in order to fairly allocate clubs, **only ONE booking will be available for each child in the first instance.** Clubs with spaces will be re-opened after the first round of bookings has been completed, and at that point a second club can be booked should your child wish to do another.

Nathaniel Newton After School Clubs

Thursday 14th September 2023

This term we will be offering after school clubs to both Years One and Two with the exception of Cooking which is Year Two only. The details of the clubs are overleaf. Please log on to the School Cloud website to book your child's place. You will find the instructions for doing so overleaf. By signing your child up to a club you agree to the 'school expectations', which can be found on the back page.

All clubs this half term are £2 per session.

Places are allocated on a first come first served basis and booking will open on Thursday 14th September at 7pm and will close on Sunday 17th September. Clubs will start week commencing Monday 18th September and will run for 6 weeks. The final week of clubs will be week commencing Monday 23rd October.

In order to ensure fairness for everyone, children are restricted to a maximum of **ONE CLUB ONLY (in the first instance)**. There may be the opportunity to book one additional club if there are spaces available. The clubs with available spaces will reopen on Monday 18th September at 7pm.

Could we also remind you of our school expectations for after school clubs which are on the last page of this information.

Occasionally it is necessary to cancel after school clubs at short notice, please check for messages during the afternoon of your child's club.

Collecting your child - the after school clubs will finish at 4:10pm. Please can parents line up on the main school playground and your child will be dismissed from here by Mrs Reynolds.

Guide to booking on School Cloud

- Navigate to the website
www.nathanielnewtoninfant.schoolcloud.co.uk
- Log in by entering your details and your child's details. These must match the information that we hold for you in school.
- Scroll to After School Clubs Autumn Term 1 2023 and click on **Continue** - open for bookings.
- Here you will find a list of all the available clubs available to book for your child.
- Select the club your child would like to attend by clicking the + button.
- Scroll to the bottom click **Next**
- Click Confirm to book the club listed for your child.

Confirmation email will be sent out so please check your inbox.

After School Club Expectations

1. All children signed up to a club will be expected to attend, unless we have verbal or written communication from a parent or carer, or if they are ill. If we do not receive notification your child will be sent to their respective club.
2. Parents or carers should inform the school office if their child is not attending a club.
3. Children should be collected promptly at the end of the session, at 4.10pm. If children are being collected by somebody else please notify the school.
4. Children will be expected to follow school rules whilst in their club and to respond to instructions given by an adult. External providers have been informed of the school relationships policy and they will communicate with school staff to share any behaviour issues which will then be communicated to parents.
5. If children do not attend regularly, their place may be withdrawn and offered to another child who may wish to attend.

These expectations are to reinforce the importance of safeguarding within school as it is our duty to ensure our children's safety at all times.
