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
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Important information

Admissions into school for Reception in September 2024

Parents will need to apply for a place at school for September 2024 if your child was born between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020 (for a place in Reception).

The application process opens on 1 November 2023.

You must apply for a Reception place by 5pm on 15th January 2024.


