- Research and try out a baking recipe (e.g. bread rolls/loaf/plaits/sticks).
- Watch clips/videos pf the Great Fire of London (eg. Horrible Histories).
- Learn a poem/Write a song about the Great Fire of London.
- Make a shop sign for the bakery Pudding Lane.
