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



## Mother's Day Celebration Afternoon - Friday 8th March

Mums are invited to join us in school from 1.30pm on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March. During the afternoon each class will do a short presentation for mums in their classrooms. We have organised the timings so that mums with children in other classes can see both presentations. During the afternoon there will be the opportunity to take part in a range of craft activities.
