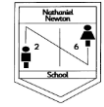




Junk Jungle Topic Fact Sheet



Recycle	The process of taking materials ready to be thrown away and converting (changing) them into reusable materials.
3D	A three-dimensional object is solid and has three dimensions: height, width, and depth.
Free-standing	Standing alone on its own foundation free of attachment or support.
Sculpture	A sculpture is a piece of art that is made by shaping materials like clay, wood, or metal into a three-dimensional form, meaning you can see it from all sides.
Artist	An artist is someone who uses their imagination and skills to create things that are beautiful or express ideas and feelings, like paintings, stories, or music
Carved	Something that has been cut into a shape, or design usually by hand.
Assembled	When things are put together.
Joined	Something that has been connected or joined together.
Technique	A special way of doing something that takes skill and practise.
Sketch	A quick and simple drawing.
Features	The important parts of something.
Mammal	Animals that are covered in fur and give birth to live young.
Vertebrate	Animals that have backbones.
