



Christmas Concerts

Dear Parents/Carers,

Children have started preparing for their Christmas Concert performances, which we hope you will enjoy attending soon.

Each year group will perform their play twice: a morning performance and an afternoon performance. Each child will be issued with **TWO virtual tickets** for EITHER the morning or afternoon performance or one of each.

Dates of the performances are as follows:

- **Reception** – Tuesday 9th December, 2:00 pm (**ADULTS ONLY**)
- **Reception** – Wednesday 10th December, 9:10 am
- **Year 1** – Thursday 11th December, 2:00 pm (**ADULTS ONLY**)
- **Year 1** – Friday 12th December, 9:10 am
- **Year 2** – Monday 15th December, 2:00 pm (**ADULTS ONLY**)
- **Year 2** – Tuesday 16th December, 9:10 am

We prefer that babies and toddlers **DO NOT** attend the performances, to allow the children to perform to the best of their ability without distractions. Please arrange alternative care for younger siblings while attending the concert.

If this is absolutely impossible, younger siblings may attend the **MORNING** performances only. Please book accordingly. If your child becomes unsettled during the performance, you will need to step outside to calm them. Younger siblings will not be admitted to the **AFTERNOON** performances.

Seats are allocated on a first come, first served basis, so please book early to avoid disappointment.
