Christmas

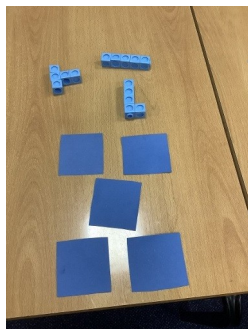
We have been busy making cards, calendars and decorations. We enjoyed a visit to church where we enjoyed singing Christmas songs.

We worked really hard learning new songs for our Christmas concert - The Nativity. The children were fantastic, remembering their lines and singing beautifully - we are very proud of them all!



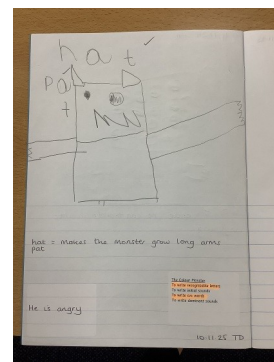
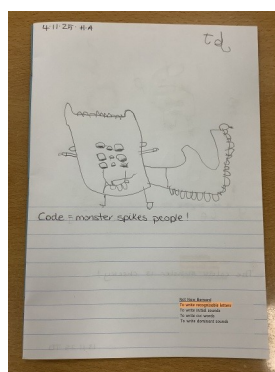
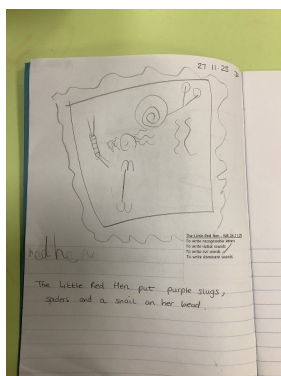
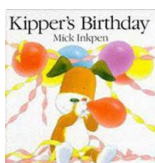
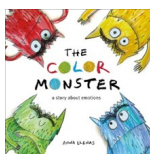
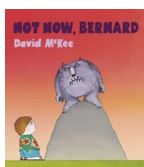
Maths
