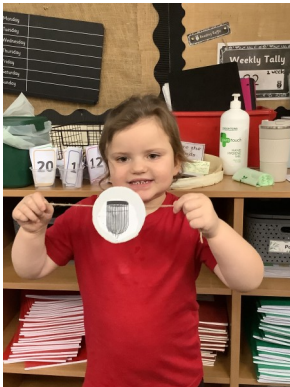


Year 1 Classroom News

Spring Term 1 — February 2026

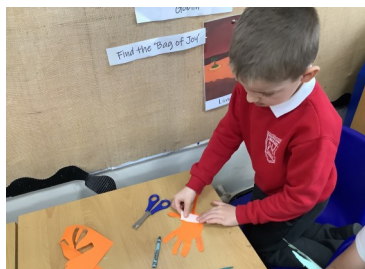
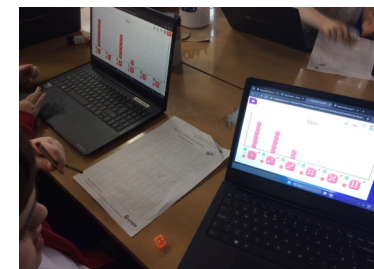
