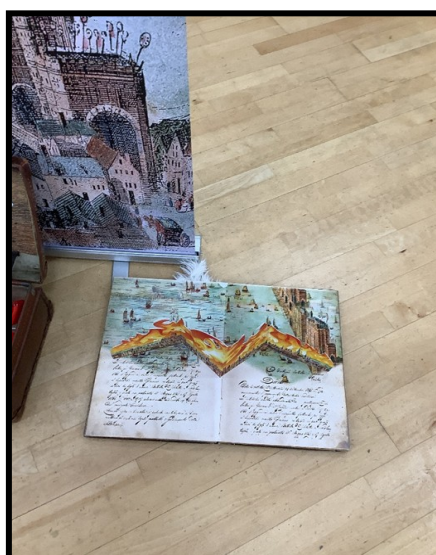
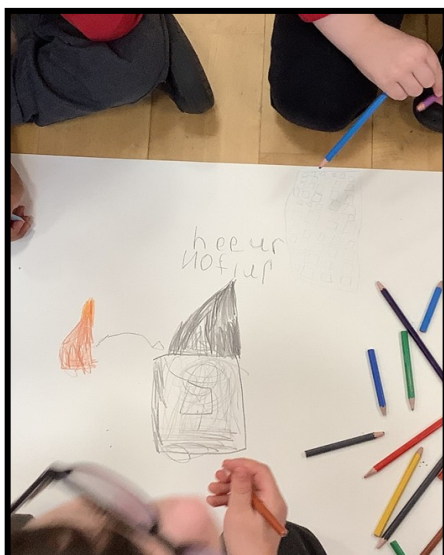
Spring Term 1 — February 2026

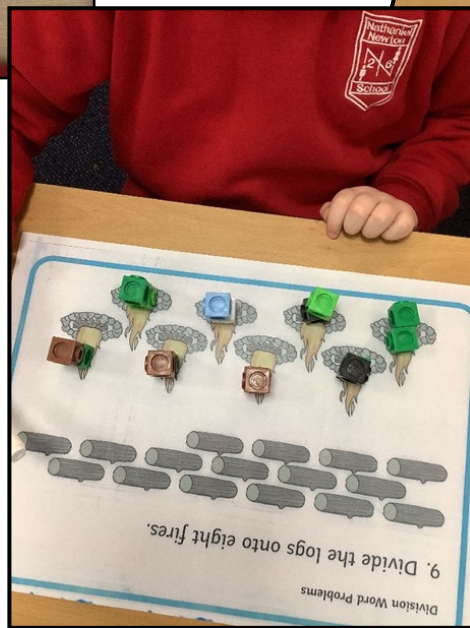
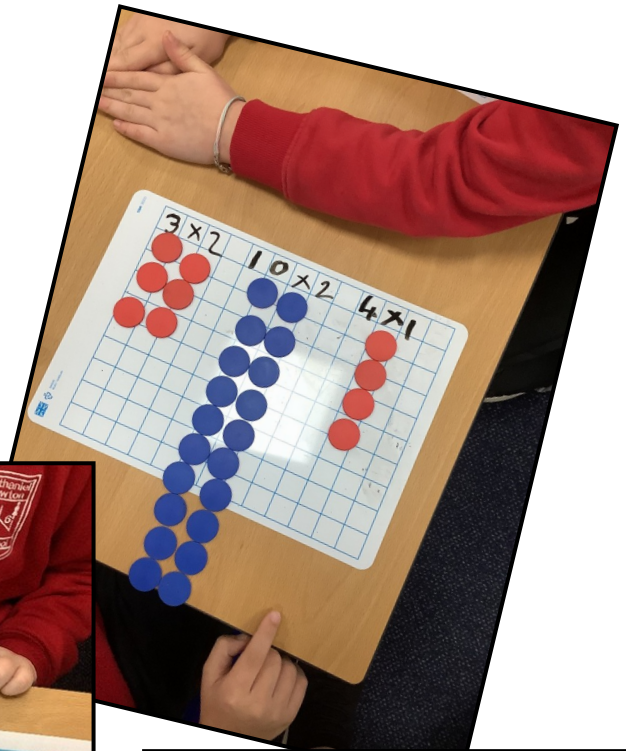
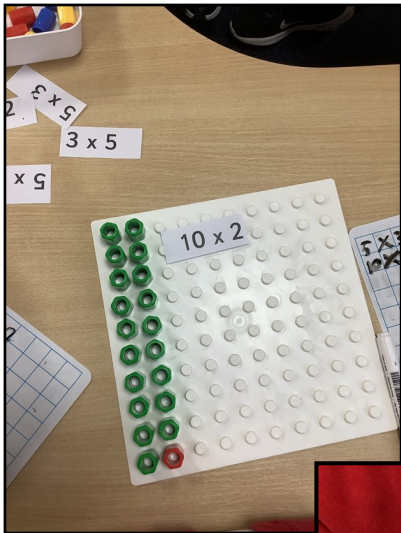

In Science the children worked in teams to make Habitats. This was a fun way to conclude our topic. Make sure to have a look in the locker areas on Parents Evening where they are on display!



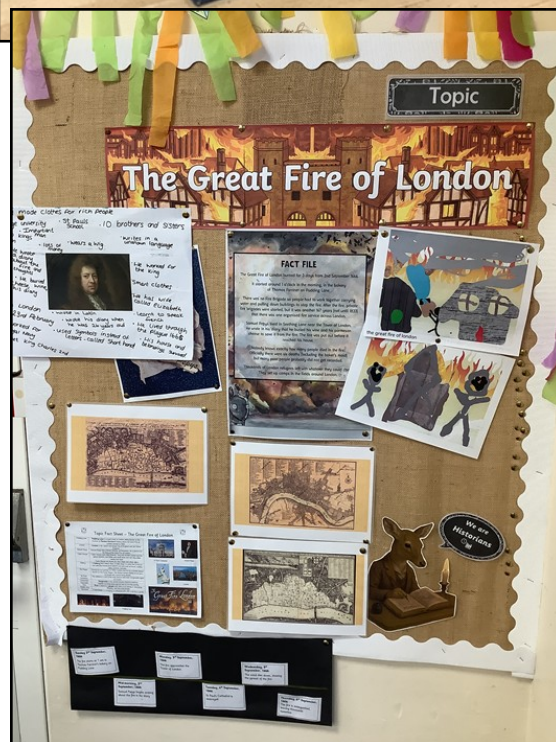
