

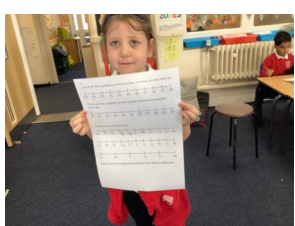
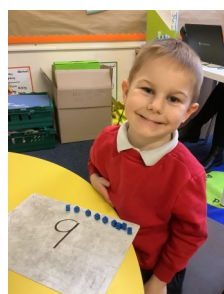
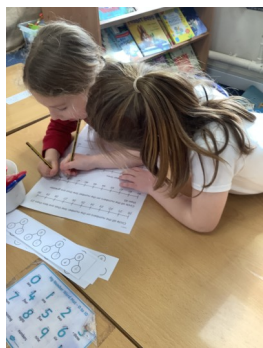
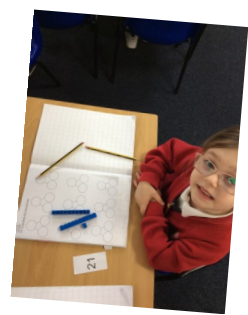
Year 1 Classroom News

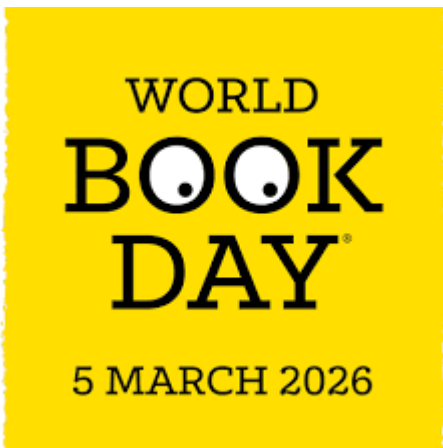
Exploring Plants
