

#### Reception

#### Areas parents feel need developing

#### Reception

- It would be nice to have a run down, maybe a letter to parents, of how the children have been doing in school that week or every two weeks as my son is not the best at telling me what he does at school.
- The only thing I have to say is that there is never enough places for all the children regarding discos.
- At lunchtimes my son has the same meal every day. This could be monitored better to make sure the children eat a varied lunch
- The only issue I find is my daughter coming home without cardigans and staff not knowing where they are. Luckily her friends mum realised and returned them.
- We would love to be able to sign in for any school clubs but places are very limited. Also
  we would like to have some music related clubs like dance, choir, music instrument
  learning etc.

- Recently I was not informed that my son was pupil of the week and therefore missed the assembly.
- I do not feel as a parent that I have been kept up to date on the teacher situation. I feel the school has failed apart from 1 or 2 text messages to even tell me who my child's teacher is.
- My child is an intelligent child and sometimes needs to be pushed slightly to achieve a
  higher level of work. It is disappointing to hear that he can't move onto the next years'
  work in order to progress and be challenged. Homework could also be more challenging
  and adapted to his level. I know his teachers would challenge him if the curriculum allowed
  for it.
- We felt £1 to dress up on World Book Day made the £1 book voucher less of a treat especially after spending money on making the costume.
- Read, Write inc, seems to have made him good at phonics but some of the books are rather dull!
- My son likes this school but the lack of continuity within the class, particularly with his
  teacher concerns me. In my opinion the homework from reception was more challenging
  and more thorough considering it was a year group behind. Now and again my son has an
  issue with a child in his class. I feel that my son is undervalued for his good behaviour

whereas naughty children seem to get more rewarded for what little good behaviour is shown. In one respect I was disappointed that his class in year 1 was the same as reception. Core friends / close relationships kept but mix of children would've been more useful. I think this would help diversify and encourage more socialisation, thus readying them for their experience of class systems at junior school.

- Some homework set over the holidays a bit too much for them to learn during the time off.

  But definitely good to help them continue to learn whilst off school.
- School crossing patrol should be brought back, if only to stop people parking on the zig zag yellow lines.
- My only concern is the small group of parents that meet every morning outside the school
  gates and deem it acceptable to smoke and use foul language. Whilst I understand there is
  no law that forbids smoking in public places, I don't wish to be exposed to this and
  certainly don't believe children should be.
- With regards to homework, some of the reading books my son brings home can be uninteresting and not engaging so we have started to read our own books together such as David Walliams or Roald Dahl.
- I know there have been some issues with parents parking on the zig zags outside school.
   Driving past a school in Bedworth the other day I noticed they were having blue posts fitted on the footpath where the zigzags were so no cars could be parked. Maybe an idea to look at.
- I think it would be good if we could get more frequent feedback on my child's
  performance. Three times a year doesn't feel enough especially if there were any issues in
  order to be able to rectify this.
- The parking outside of the school still remains an issue, is there an option to look at reappointing a lollipop lady as she seemed to do a great job at stopping people from parking on the yellow zigzags, or is there an option to have a teacher out there before school to prevent people from parking there.
