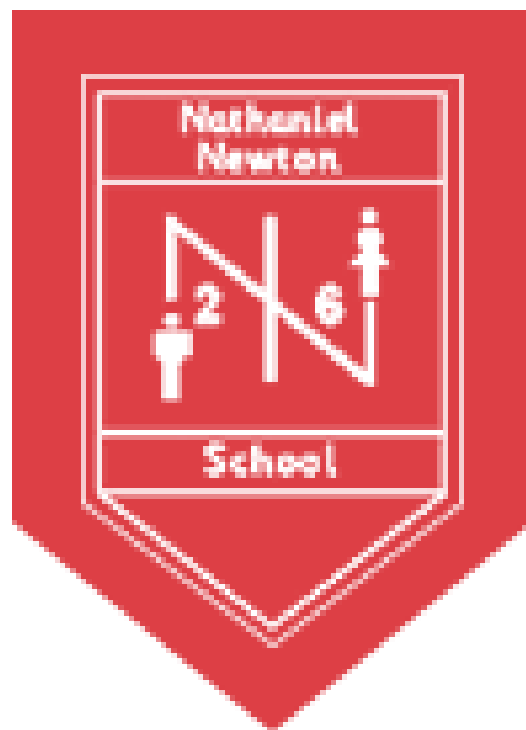

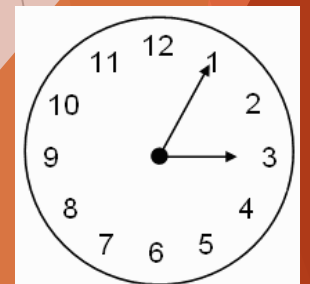
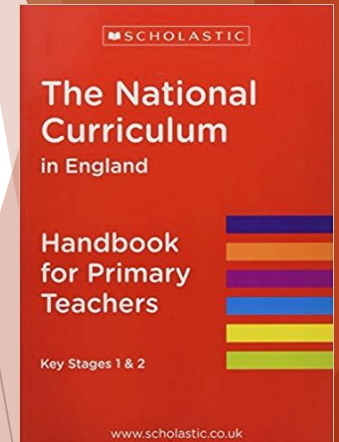

The Day

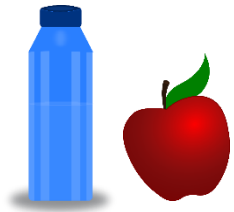
- Doors open at 8:45am, teaching assistants will stand on the door until 8:55am, if you need to pass on any messages to your child's teacher or ask any questions they will be able to support you. If you arrive late please take your child to the main reception to register them.
- The daily curriculum changes, however the outline of the day usually starts with Phonics, Maths, English based learning in the morning and then the afternoons more topic based foundation subjects such as History, Geography, Music, Art/Design, PE, RE, PSHE etc.
- At 3:05pm classes will come out onto the playground, please stand back on the playground so the children can see clearly. Children will look for their grown-up put their hand up to inform the teacher, once the teacher/TA has seen the grown-up the child can then go. If your child is being picked up by someone else, please let us know each time for safety reasons.



KS1 Routines



- Children are reminded to go to the toilet regularly at break time, before and after lunchtime, before PE sessions etc. If they need to go to the toilet during the day they can go, usually one at a time. (Please put a spare pair of pants in their PE bag)



- Children have fruit tuck at 10:20 each day as part of their playtime which is provided by the school. Children are required to have a water bottle with them in school at all times, this can be sent into school on Monday and come home on a Friday – water fountains are in school to refill bottles. If you wish to send in an additional drink for tuck time this must only be juice and not fizzy or energy based drinks.

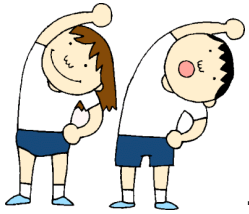
- Read Write Inc Books will be changed according to the stage of RWI book children are on some may be daily ditties, every 3 days or every 5 days. (Starting from next week). If your child is off the RWI programme during phonics they will be in a GPS group working on grammar, punctuation and spelling.





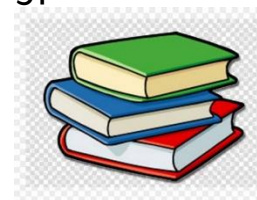
KS1 Routines

- Congratulations assemblies are held at 9:00am on Wednesday mornings, you will receive a text message from the office when your child is being celebrated in assembly. Children are also welcome to bring in celebrations from home such as swimming certificates, dance/sports awards etc.
- Children will have two PE sessions a week, these days alter from time to time so please ensure that your child always has a PE kit in school. If you wish to take kit home to wash please do this on a Friday and return on a Monday. We also send the kits home every half-term with children. Earrings should be removed or covered with tape.
- On the days that children don't take part in a PE session they will take part in our daily mile, a quick 10 minute running/walking active break.
- As part of our personal, social, health and emotional learning we follow the PATHS programme. Within this we have a star of the week who helps out with special jobs throughout the day and other children give the star of the week a compliment at the end of the week.



Home Learning

- Children will also be given a home reading book to read alongside their Read Write Inc books at home. Children can change their book as many times as they wish in a week they just need to hand it in with their red home school liaison book in the morning, we recommend that they change it at least once a week. When reading with your child please write a comment or note in their home school reading book.
- On a Friday children will be given a maths activity sheet to complete, to be returned by the next Friday. The activity will be based on the aspect of mathematics we have been learning this week. Children will be rewarded with stars for completing maths home learning.
- Before the new half-term we will send out a Topic Fact File containing new vocabulary to discuss based on our next topic.
- At the beginning of the new half-term there will be a menu of homework activities in which you can complete together with your children, the style of these activities will range so you can choose to complete the type of homework that suits your child the best.

Historical Language	Past, before, then, after, now, present, memory and change

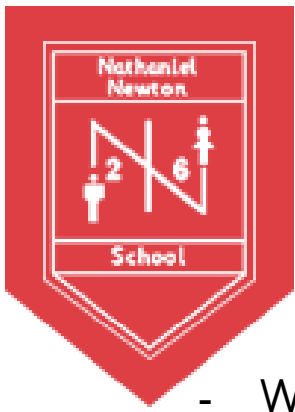

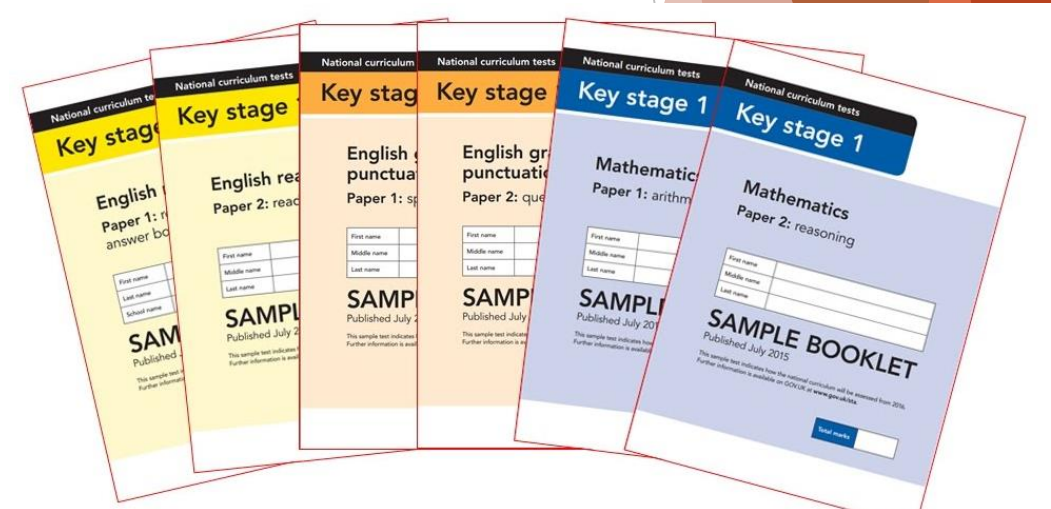
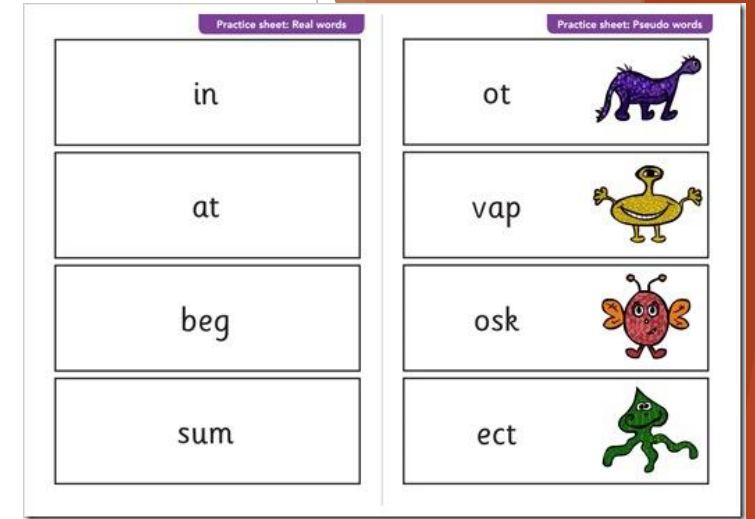

Letters and meetings will be held prior to both of these.



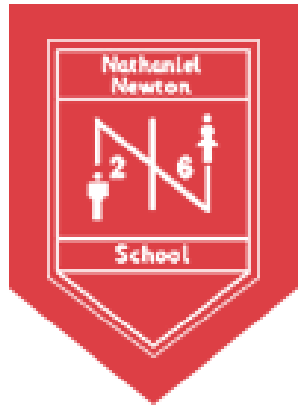
